**A Bill to Approve the Undergraduate Student Government 2024 Spring Semester Budget**

President Bobby Arthur McAlpine (for himself, Vice President Madison Mason, and Chief Financial Officer Omar Al Kowatli) introduced the following bill to the Allocations Committee where it passed, and then to the floor, where it passed.

**Whereas** the Undergraduate Student Government represents all undergraduate students at The Ohio State University; and

**Whereas** the President, Vice President, and Chief Financial Officer executed a detailed budget process with a duration of 2.5 months; and

**Whereas** this process uniquely included student body feedback, Student Life business office consultation, *(former)* USG advisor consultation, intense line-item scrutiny, among other things; and

**Whereas** the process successfully yielded a polished budget to help the Undergraduate Student Government “Bridge the Gap” to the student body and continue its mission of being Students Serving Students; and

**Whereas** this polished budget has been fully endorsed by all members of the McAlpine-Mason Administration’s Senior Staff; and

**Whereas** semester budgets are presented to the Allocations Committee; and

**Whereas** the Allocations Committee approved USG’s 2024 Spring Semester budget; and

**Whereas** the President, Vice President, Chief Financial Officer, and/or the Senior Director of Allocations must submit the finalized budget approved by the Allocations Committee to all members of the General Assembly; and

**Whereas** senators of the General Assembly have the ability to propose line-item amendments to the budget.


