**Whereas** the Undergraduate Student Government represents all undergraduate students at The Ohio State University; and

Whereas semester budgets are presented to the Allocations Committee; and

Whereas the General Assembly approved USG's 2024 Spring Semester budget: and

**Whereas** senators of the General Assembly have the ability to propose amendments to the budget; and

**Whereas** the Government Relations Committee attends an annual advocacy trip to Washington DC; and

Whereas 12 students will be attending, and the cost covers travel, housing, and food; and

Whereas the current budget allocated creates a disparity for those able to attend as they would be required to fund many aspects themselves; and

Whereas financial research has indicated that the \$3,660 allocated by the original budget is not is not sufficient to fund the trip; and

**Therefore, Let it Be Resolved** that the General Assembly allocates a total of \$6,000 to fund the Annual DC advocacy trip at The Ohio State University.
