## A Resolution to Amend the Organizational Bylaws to Add a Seat for the College of Business

Keyanah Peters (for themselves) introduced the following resolution to the Oversight Committee where it passed. Then, to the floor where it passed/failed.

**Whereas** the Undergraduate Student Government represents all undergraduate students at The Ohio State University; and

Whereas the Organization Bylaws of the Undergraduate Student Government can be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the General Assembly; and

**Whereas** there are currently 42 academic area and living area seats and 3 emissary seats in the 56<sup>th</sup> General Assembly; and

Whereas there currently are three (3) seats representing the College of Business in the General Assembly; and

Whereas the average academic area senator represents approximately 1,800-2,000 students; and

**Whereas** this number comes from the outdated Fisher College of Business Class Profile of 6,627; and

Whereas Ohio State's Fisher College of Business has grown in recent years to 8,132 students as of Autumn 2023<sup>1</sup>; and

Whereas the College of Business currently makes up 17.8% of the Undergraduate Student Body; and

Whereas adding an additional business seat will help the Undergraduate Student Government more accurately represent the undergraduate student body of Fisher College of Business; and

**Therefore, Let it Be Resolved** that the proposed amendments to the Organizational Bylaws are affixed as 'Appendix A' in this resolution; and
