

## Appendix A

### Article VII

#### C. Obligations

1. The Speaker of the General Assembly may compel the Chief Justice of the Judicial Panel to present a judicial report to the General Assembly.
  - a. The Judicial Report will be delivered in the same manner as the Executive Report.
  - b. If the Chief Justice has a reasonable conflict, they must find an alternate to take their place.
    - i. The alternate must be an Associate Justice of the Judicial Panel.
  - c. The Speaker of the General Assembly must inform the Chief Justice at least 48 hours in advance of the General Assembly meeting to which the Chief Justice has been called.
    - i. The Speaker of the General Assembly will take reasonable steps to ensure that the Chief Justice or their alternate has enough context to prepare the report.
  - d. Failure to appear before the General Assembly upon the speaker's compulsion shall be considered a dereliction of duty.
