**A Resolution to Approve University Senate and University Governance Committee  
Appointments**

Vice President Madison Mason (for herself) introduced the following resolution to the Oversight Committee where it passed, then to the floor where it passed.

**Whereas** the Undergraduate Student Government represents all undergraduate students at The Ohio State University, and

**Whereas** University Senators are members of Ohio State's University Senate, the shared governing body comprised of 141 faculty, administrators, staff, and students, and

**Whereas** the Undergraduate Student Government may appoint representatives to University Senate Committees according to University Rules and the Undergraduate Student Government Constitution and Bylaws, and


**Whereas** the 26 undergraduate University Senators who ensure the student voice is heard in all high-level university conversations and decisions and advising campus leaders on the key educational and academic policy concerns, along with voting on academic program changes and faculty rule changes, and


**Whereas** these appointments were selected based on soliciting interest primarily from members of the Undergraduate Student Government and secondarily from the general student body, and

**Whereas** all appointments underwent a 3-tier reviewal process of the Undergraduate Caucus Vice Chairs, Chair of the Undergraduate Caucus, and Vice President of the Undergraduate Student Government.

**Therefore, Let it Be Resolved** that the General Assembly shall approve the attached University Senate and University Governance Committee Appointments.
