## A Bill to Amend the Undergraduate Student Government 2024 Autumn Semester Budget

President Bobby McAlpine (for himself, Vice President Justin Robinson, Chief Financial Officer Aryav Yadapadithaya, and Senior Director of Allocations Hanniel Diaz Elizarraga) introduced the following bill to the Allocations Committee where it passed, and then to the floor, where it passed.

**Whereas** the Undergraduate Student Government (USG) represents all undergraduate students at The Ohio State University; and

**Whereas** USG has the ability to request additional funding from the Council of Student Affairs (CSA) to support specific initiatives; and

**Whereas** USG requested additional funding for the following initiatives: New York Times Accessibility Testing, Off-Campus Safety Products, Test Prep Resource Library, and Expansion of News Resources Beyond the New York Times; and

Whereas the allocation of these funds is detailed in Appendix A; and

Whereas CSA allocations are restricted to their originally prescribed purposes; and

**Whereas** the General Assembly previously approved the 2024 Autumn Semester budget for the McAlpine-Robinson Administration for the 2024–2025 academic year; and

**Whereas** any amendments to the budget must first be reviewed and approved by the Allocations Committee; and

**Whereas** the Allocations Committee has approved an amendment to the 2024 Autumn Semester budget; and

Whereas the President, Chief Financial Officer, and Senior Director of Allocations are required to submit this amendment to all members of the General Assembly;

**Therefore, Let it Be Resolved** that the General Assembly approves amending the Undergraduate Student Government 2024 Autumn Semester budget to include four additional

line items, as specif	fied in Appendix A,	, to reflect the a	dditional alloca	tions provided	by the
Council of Student	Affairs.
