After having passed [50-R-7: A Resolution to Oppose the Ban on Window Art in Campus Residence Halls](#), I have continued to try to push this policy changed to the university and will continue until the policy is changed and students can free express themselves.

I have been meeting with administrators in the College of Food, Agriculture, and Environmental Sciences to discuss how I can help the students in CFAES. Most of this conversation has centered around the transition of ATI students to Ohio State, specifically helping students adjust to the drastic culture change between Wooster and Columbus. This includes potentially expanded current peer mentor programs to include one specifically for ATI transition students. This is a work in progress with the CFAES administration and is in very early stages.

I have also met with Katie Hall (President Drake's Chief of Staff), Dr. Matt Couch (Director of Student Activities/USG Adviser), and Dr. Gretchen Metzelaars (Sr. Associate Vice President for Student Life) to discuss issues including campus culture and climate, free speech issues that have arose on campus, and other issues that constituents have brought to my attention.
