

**A Resolution to Increase Transparency Under Blue, the New SEI System**

Chase Barnett (for himself, Kate Greer, Amraha Nadeem, and Nate Smith) introduced the following legislation to the Steering Committee, where it passed.

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**Whereas** the Undergraduate Student Government represents all undergraduate students at The Ohio State University, and

**Whereas** The Ohio State University’s Registrar’s Office, the University Senate SEI Committee, and other administrative offices are updating the SEI database platform from PeopleSoft to Blue within the next few months, and

**Whereas** SEI stands for “Student Evaluations of Instruction,” and

**Whereas** PeopleSoft, the current SEI system in place, only displays the results for the last question which is “What is your overall rating of this professor/class?” for students to view, and

**Whereas** Ohio State provides questions in the evaluation, which is standard across colleges and departments, for students to assess their professors’ teaching performances, and

**Whereas** the topics of inquiry in the ten SEI questions fall into three main categories of organization, interest in students, and preparation, and

**Whereas** these results are used by individual professors, departments, and administrative bodies to evaluate the teaching styles and overall performance of Ohio State faculty across colleges and departments, and

**Whereas** the new SEI platform, Blue, will have exponentially more capabilities than PeopleSoft in visual data analysis and viewing privileges for students and faculty alike;

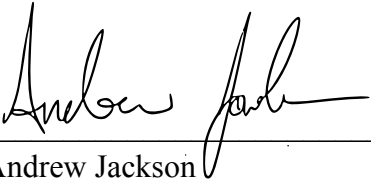
**Therefore, Let it Be Resolved** that the Undergraduate Student Government supports the addition of further SEI results to BuckeyeLink through Blue to increase transparency for students, and

43 on BuckeyeLink before they sign up to take a class with a certain professor, and  
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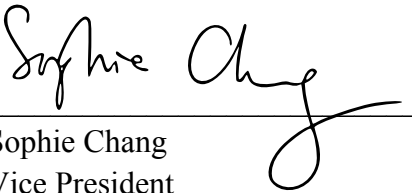
45 **Let it Further Be Resolved** that a summative statistic be created for each of the three

51 transparency of SEI results and improve students' course scheduling processes by  
52 ensuring that their future professors' teaching methods are compatible with their personal
