

A Resolution to Approve Addition of the Deputy Chief Financial Officer to the Organizational Bylaws

Daniel Marchese (for himself) introduced the following resolution to the Oversight Committee where it passed unanimously.

Whereas the Undergraduate Student Government represents all undergraduate students at The Ohio State University, and

Whereas the Organizational Bylaws provide both structure and procedure for the Undergraduate Student Government, and

Whereas the Chief Financial Officer of Undergraduate Student Government is an essential position that serves one of the core functions of the organization, and

Whereas in the past, the position of CFO has been occupied by a single person managing both the General Assembly and Cabinet funds, and

Whereas the current administration has split the duties of CFO between two people, the CFO, who manages Cabinet funds, and the Deputy CFO, who manages General Assembly funds and chairs the Allocations Committee, and

Whereas CFO/Deputy CFO model has proven effective for managing the Undergraduate Student Government's funds, and

Whereas the Organizational Bylaws do not currently reflect the CFO/Deputy CFO model;


Therefore Let it Be Resolved that the General Assembly approves of the attached changes to the Organizational Bylaws adding the Deputy CFO position, and

Let it Further Be Resolved that these changes shall remain in effect until such a time where they are changed or replaced by procedures provided in the Constitution and Bylaws.
