

A Resolution to Enhance Organizational Outreach

Zack Stross (for himself, Emmy Wydman, Evelyn Kennedy, and Jacob Rollins) introduced the following legislation into the Outreach Committee where it passed.

Whereas the Undergraduate Student Government represents all undergraduate students at The Ohio State University, and

Whereas the Undergraduate Student Government allocates part of the Student Activity Fee to organizations on campus, and

Whereas the Allocations Committee serves as a subset of the General Assembly, and

Whereas many student organizations are unaware of the Allocations Committee process and could greatly benefit from additional funding, and

Whereas outreach to organizations is an essential part of the Undergraduate Student Government, and senators have a responsibility to represent their constituencies, and

Whereas utilizing senators to assist with campus outreach could increase student organization participation in the funding process, and

Whereas speaking to organizations would broaden students’ knowledge of the Undergraduate Student Government and its functions;

Therefore Let it Be Resolved that the Undergraduate Student Government senators be required to visit two organizations relevant to their constituency or their committee at any time during each semester, and organization selections need to be SUBMITTED FOR approval TO the Director or Deputy Director of Outreach one week prior to each presentation, and


Let it Further Be Resolved that after speaking to organizations, the senators shall report their attendance regarding their presentation in the Google Form which will be recorded by either the Director or a Deputy Director of Outreach, and

Let it Further Be Resolved that if a senator fails to uphold this commitment, he or she is up for removal from his or her position.
