,	Whereas Loyola University – Chicago has a program to prevent bird collisions, ³			
	Therefore Let it Be Resolved that the Undergraduate Student Government (USG) at The Ohio State University supports the implementation of measures that reduce and/or prevent the collisions of migratory birds into buildings around campus, and			
	Let it Further Be Resolved that USG suggests that birdfeeders be placed around buildings with large windows to redirect migratory paths, and			
	Let it Further Be Resolved that USG suggests that Ohio State students minimize their light usage and close their blinds during nighttime or times of darkness.
