Whereas this version of the approved Constitution will commence with the inauguration of the 51st General Assembly, and


Whereas there exist in the approved document some spelling, grammatical, and formatting errors, and

Whereas the formatting errors are mostly in the form of capitalization, and


Whereas it is important for the longevity of this version of the USG Constitution to be correct in spelling, grammar, and formatting;
