# Organizational Bylaws

of the Undergraduate Student Government  
of The Ohio State University

Amended by resolution of the General Assembly

## *Article I: The General Assembly*

### A. General Assembly Constituency

  - o. Exploration – 1 seat
  - p. North Campus Living Area – 2 seats
  - q. Off-Campus Living Area – 6 seats
  - r. Commuter Living Area – 2 seats
  - s. South Campus Living Area – 3 seats
  - t. West Campus Living Area – 1 seat
  - u. Regional Campus Living Area – 1 seat

  - f. College of Nursing – 1 seat

  - h. College of Public Health – 1 seat

  - j. College of Education and Human Ecology – 2 seats
