<b>Whereas</b> many students with ME/NA descent do not identify with or have the same life experiences of being white in the United States, especially in a post-9/11 environment of anti-Arab and anti-Muslim discrimination, and
Whereas the lack of identification of a ME/NA category negatively impacts students, faculty, and staff in various ways, such as: tracking retention rates and student recruitment, identifying trends in the hiring of faculty, staff, and administration, bias, reporting, and having the ability to reach the community of key issues that impact it, and
<b>Whereas</b> the ME/NA community has been left out of processes and resource allocation for the aforementioned, and
<b>Whereas</b> The Ohio State University's ability to ascertain who identifies with the ME/NA community is a necessary step in developing programs and interventions to address any disparities and to achieve diversity, equity, and inclusion goals, and
Whereas the ME/NA racial category must represent persons with origins in the Middle East/North Africa regardless of their nativity status or parental place of birth; and includes the population with origins in the League of Arab States (Algeria, Bahrain, Comoros, Djibouti, Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Mauritania, Morocco, Oman, Palestine, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, and Yemen); Non-Arab ME/NA States (Turkey, Iran, and Israel) and transnational communities (Assyrians/Chaldeans, Kurds, Berber, et cetera), and
Whereas the University of Michigan passed a similar resolution, A.R. 6-039, <sup>4</sup> and
<b>Whereas</b> the Association of Big Ten Students passed a similar resolution, ABTS 01.18.02, <sup>5</sup> and
<b>Whereas</b> the University of California has added a similar category on their applications, and collects data on students from that category; <sup>6</sup>
<b>Therefore, Let it Be Resolved</b> that the Undergraduate Student Government at The Ohio State University recognizes the need for a ME/NA racial category to be added to all university documents that collect racial and ethnic demographic data in order to identify the ME/NA community on our campus, and
