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164 **Let it Further Be Resolved** that the minutes from the Secretary of the General Assembly all  
165 stand approved, and

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167 **Let it Further Be Resolved** that the two 49th General Assembly officers serve *pro tempore* until  
168 they are replaced by an officer from the 50th General Assembly, and

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170 **Let it Further Be Resolved** that 49-R-8, 49-R-9, and 49-R-40 shall remain in effect until  
171 modified or overturned by a future session of the General Assembly, and

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173 **Let it Further Be Resolved** that, effective the adoption of the reports above, on March 29, 2017,  
174 the 49th General Assembly of the Undergraduate Student Government shall stand adjourned *sine*  
175 *diem*.
