After talking with members of my constituency as well as members of the student body as a whole, I have come to the conclusion that two major areas of concern are Affordability and the relationship between Housing and Dining. As of right now, I am working with some of my fellow senators two resolutions. One resolution would recommend that new dining facilities be created to serve the much larger population of students now living on campus. The other resolution would recommend and incentivize professors to use less costly textbooks, create their own, or take other actions to drive down student costs to take their classes.

Additionally, I have supported and voted for efforts like 49-R-10, a resolution that expanded the use and accessibility of SEIs, increasing transparency and helping students to evaluate courses before signing up for them, as well as 49-R-12, which supported increasing the max number of credit hours a student can take without incurring extra fees.
